Clarissa Harlowe "Clara" Barton was born in the small North Oxford farmhouse on Christmas day 1821. A timid, bashful child, Clara grew into a courageous, compassionate leader known the world over for her work as a Civil War battlefield nurse and American National Red Cross founder – yet ironically she did not recognize her own selfless bravery. Over 180 years after her birth, the incredible stories of Clara Barton continue to draw people to this great humanitarian's birthplace to learn about her life of boundless mercy and commitment.
